COME WALK WITH US!

Friday, 21 February, 2020 10/6km (IVV credit only)

START: 7:00-10:00AM FINISH BY: 1:00PM

In downtown San Antonio; include the River Walk, the Alamo, La Villita Arts Village, Main Plaza and El Mercado.

Saturday, 22 February, 2020 42/21/13/5km (IML & IVV credit)

START: 6:45-7:15AM (42/21km) 7:30-10:00AM (all walks) FINISH BY: 5:00PM

The Marathon takes River Walk South & city streets through all the UNESCO World Heritage Missions, and back! For the 21km you are bussed to the furthest mission, Espada, and walk back. The 13km walk is to Mission Concepción & back. The 5km walk will be on the River Walk and city streets, including the historic King William neighborhood.

Sunday, 23 February, 2020 21/13/5km (IML & IVV credit)

START: 7:30-8:00AM (21km) 8:00-10:00AM (all walks) FINISH BY: 4:00PM

The walks head north on the River Walk through The Pearl, Brackenridge Park and the historic Japanese Tea Garden.

ELIGIBILITY: Noncompetitive. Walk, jog or run at your own pace. The events are open to everyone. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Everyone must register. The events will be held regardless of weather. **DISCLAIMER:** The sponsors are not liable for injuries, accidents, thefts, and/or material damage. **ROUTES:** All routes are rated 1A. With the exception of a few stairs, walks are suitable for wheelchairs and strollers. There are places to eat and drink along most of the routes. **RESTROOMS & WATER:** Are available at the Start/Finish and along the routes. **PETS:** Leashed pets are welcome but will limit your ability to sightsee. Owners must pick up after their pets. Pets are not allowed in buildings and it is against the law in San Antonio to leave a pet in a car unattended.

EVENT HOTEL: All events will start at the **Holiday Inn-Downtown** (Market Square) located at 318 W. César Chávez Blvd, San Antonio TX 78204.

HOTEL RESERVATIONS: Our block reservations are filled.



Y'ALL COME!

From Dallas & Austin: Follow I-35E and I-35 S to San Antonio. Take exit 155B from I-35 S. **From Houston:** Follow I-10 W and take exit 155B from I-10 W/I-35 N. **From the Airport, via car:** Follow signs to US-281 S. Continue on US-281 S to Tower of the Americas Way/I-37 S. Take exit 140B from I-37 S. Drive to W César E. Chávez Blvd. **From the Airport, via public transport:** San Antonio is served by both Uber & Lyft; use their mobile app. Taxis are available at the curb. Tickets for the downtown hotel shuttle (one-way: \$15.00, round trip: \$28.00) can be purchased at baggage claim. **For more transport information,** visit Texastrailroundup.org and look under the logistics tab.

COST

Preregistration has closed, but you may register on site.

We accept cash, check or credit card, \$USD only, please.

Friday: \$3.00. The Friday Friendship walk through downtown San Antonio is for IVV credit only and does not include a medal.

Saturday: \$15.00. The walk along the Mission Reach includes a medal and is for both IVV and IML credit. There is an additional \$10 charge for bus transportation to the start point (Mission Espada) for the 21k half marathon.

Sunday: \$15.00. The walk along the Museum Reach includes a medal and is for both IVV and IML credit. *(If you walk on both Saturday and Sunday you will only receive one medal.)*
